## What is the Federal Reserve?

The Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland is one of twelve regional Reserve Banks that, together with the Board of Governors in Washington, DC, makes up the Federal Reserve System, the central bank of the United States.

The Federal Reserve System formulates and implements U.S. monetary policy, supervises banks and bank holding companies, and provides financial services to depository institutions and the federal government.

The Cleveland Fed, with branch offices in Cincinnati and Pittsburgh, serves the Fourth Federal Reserve District—Ohio, western Pennsylvania, the northern panhandle of West Virginia, and eastern Kentucky. Every year since 1999, we've been named "One of Northeast Ohio's Best Places to Work" by NorthCoast 99, a program that honors 99 great workplaces for top talent in Northeast Ohio. ## Who Should Apply for an Internship at the Cleveland Fed?

Full-time students who have completed their sophomore year or above and attend an accredited college/university who also meet the following criteria should apply:

Overall GPA 3.0

Able to work 40 hours per week throughout the duration of the 10–12 week internship

Actively pursuing a bachelor's, master's, or PhD

•

Has at least one semester remaining upon completion of internship
