

# DREAM BOARD COLLAGE



**Activity Description:** Students will explore their dreams for the future by designing a dream board.

**Time Required**  
**Step 1: 15 minutes**  
**Steps 2-3: 30-45 minutes**  
**Step 4: 5 minutes**  
**Bonus: 20 minutes**

**Materials**

- Paper, poster board, or cardboard
- Ruler
- Drawing Materials
- Magazines or Newspapers

**Directions** Follow the steps below to design your Dream Board Collage

**Step 1** Using the ruler, divide a blank piece of paper, cardboard, or poster board into four squares. Each square will represent a part of your dream board. If you have a printer, you can use the dream board template for your design instead of a piece of paper.

- **Square 1:** One place you want to visit
- **Square 2:** Your dream job
- **Square 3:** One thing you would like to buy
- **Square 4:** Choose your own dream for the future

**Step 2** Be creative! Using magazines, newspapers, the internet, or your artistic skills, identify images or words that represent the topic of each square.

**Step 3** Once you've selected your images or words, draw or attach them to each section on your dream board.
